

2ND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME FOR STAFF LIST OF GRANT AWARDS AND SUBSTITUTION LISTS

AWARDING PROCESS

This scholarship allocation process includes participation in the HOPE conference to be held from 4-6 June and in the preliminary workshops on 2-3 June.

The following eligibility requirements were established:

- To be a full-time staff member or PhD student enrolled **at a Jesuit University not included among the KA171 project partner universities.**
- The abstract must have been approved by the Scientific Committee of the conference.
- To have the support of the home university and a letter confirming that the attendance to the activity is not financed by other funds.

A total of 141 applications have been received. Due to the high demand, it has not been possible to support all the applications submitted, being carried out the allocation strictly following the 2 criteria established in the call:

- 1st the mark awarded by the scientific committee to the abstract submitted.
- 2nd in case of equal score between two candidates, the earliest date of submission.

In addition to the allocation list for each region, a unique waiting list of substitutes has been established, ordered according to the same ranking criteria.

Therefore, in the event of a beneficiary's resignation, the next substitute will be contacted in that order.

GRANT RULES

Each participant will receive a unit travel help, which is calculated based on the air distance in km from his/her home university and the Loyola University in Dos Hermanas. The calculation is based on this link of the European Commission: <https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator>

The mobilities will have a fixed duration of 5 days of activity at Loyola, comprising two days of workshops: **2 and 3 June** and three days of Conference: **4, 5, and 6 June**. Two additional days for travel will be added to these 5 days. Therefore, the scholarships have been calculated for a total of 7 days. The day support will be 160€ by day.

Each participant will organise his/her own trip and accommodation. It is not necessary to present flight tickets or expenses to justify the grants. The grant will be received once the participant arrives at Loyola, not in advance as it is a requirement to actually carry out the mobility.
